Dear Mr. McGoldrick:


Receipt is acknowledged of your letter of August 26 to the  
New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"),  
and of the Supplemental Report enclosed therewith.

1. The Commission is of the opinion that a report was  
required to be filed on July 24, 1973 respecting  
all contributions and expenditures between April  
24, 1973 and July 23, 1973 for the reason that  
Section 16 of the Act does not distinguish between  
primary and general elections.

The Commission has the power under Section 6 of  
the Act to extend for good cause shown the dates  
upon which reports are required to be filed. The  
Commission finds that the newness of the Act and  
the absence of rules and regulations relating to  
filing constitute such good cause, and has extended  
the date for filing a report in conformity herewith  
to include the date of filing of your Supplemental  
Report.
