Dear Mr. Green:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 21, 1974.

In view of the heavy volume of requests for advisory opinions and the imposing time requirement resulting from pending litigation, our Counsel has not been able to respond to requests for advisory opinions.

Under the circumstances, the Commission has agreed to extend the filing deadline for those organizations who have requested advisory opinions, the answers to which will impinge on the necessity of filing by the organization. This extension includes the period during which the request is pending, plus 15 days thereafter.

I should also point out that the Superior Court of New Jersey, the Chancery Division, has continued a restraint against the enforcement of the deadline for Annual Reports pending the final outcome of litigation in that court. This interlocutory injunction, as well as the Commission's specific extension set forth in this letter, will serve to protect your client from any penalties which might otherwise be imposed as a result of Chapter 83 of the Laws of 1973.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.
