Dear Mr. Huber:

Your letter dated June 28, 1979 to the New Jersey
Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"),
including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded
to me for reply.

Under Section 11 of the Act as well as Section
19:34-33 of the Election Laws, no state, county or municipal
party committee may make a contribution on behalf of
a candidate in a primary election. The Commission has previously
ruled that this prohibition contained in the Act includes
a prohibition on contributions made after the date of the
primary election to pay off debts incurred during that election.
A copy of that opinion of the Commission (No. 0-23-76) is
enclosed herewith.
