
Dear Mr. Ortenzi:

Your letter dated February 12, 1980 to the New Jersey
Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"),
including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded

Nothing in the Act would prevent the use of the surplus
funds by your organization to support candidates for 1980 local
school board election; accordingly, the answer to your question
No. 1 is no.

Nothing in the Act would prevent your participation in the
organization because you are no longer a resident of the Town
of Lodi. Of course we cannot provide any opinion with respect
to the rules of the organization which might bear on that question.
