

MINUTES OF COMMISSION MEETING

October 29, 1973

1. In the matter of Ungerman vs. O'Keefe (Plainfield), it was determined that a hearing would be held on Friday, November 2 with Judge Goldman as the hearing officer.
2. Owens, Edwards and Hicks will be subpoenaed for an appearance on November 2, having been determined that the process server was unable to serve them for the October 29 hearing.
3. It was decided that the county candidates, by reason of the practical impossibility to determine those who have not responded to our recent letter, will be heard on Monday, November 5 at 9:00, 10:00 and 10:30
4. With respect to a meeting between the Chairman and the Director with the Attorney General, it was determined that the Commission would urge the Attorney General to make a determination with respect to alleged violations of N. J. S. A. 19:34-45. And that in the event of the Attorney General did not immediately appoint an individual to deal with the matter and dispatch him to this office for the purpose of reviewing records, we should set forth the violations which we have noted with specificity in a letter to the Attorney General.
5. Amusements of America, Inc. It was determined that they should file in the Mount Olive non-binding referendum matter.
6. Schluter vs. Martindell. It was determined to immediately place a complaint in the hands of Mrs. Martindell or her representative. The matter will be heard on Friday, November 2 with Judge Sheenan as the hearing officer. A copy of the complaint was delivered by Mr. Reiche (for hand delivery) to Mr. McGoldrick, who lives in Princeton.

NOTE: Mr. Murray, press secretary for the Martindell campaign was personally given a copy of the Schluter complaint on the evening of October 29, 1973.
