The Election Law Enforcement Commission has released for the 1984 municipal election the names of 5 candidates and for the 1984 primary election the names of 22 candidates who were reprimanded or fined for failure to comply with the New Jersey Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act.

Summary sheets are attached for the candidates fined in connection with these elections. The summary sheets give the names of the candidates, the public offices they were seeking, the type of reports filed, the number of days late, and the Commission's actions.

The Act requires that candidates spending more than \$2,000.00 file reports of their financial activities with the Commission 29 and 11 days prior to an election and 20 days after an election. Candidates spending \$2,000.00 or less are required to file a certified statement (Form A-1) with the Commission 29 days prior to an election.

Final Decisions have been mailed to all candidates and treasurers. The publication of this list is part of revised Commission procedures, begun with the 1978 primary election, designed to foster compliance, enhance disclosure, and make enforcement more effective.

All candidates are notified by the Commission of their reporting obligations. Candidates who failed to report in a timely manner are again notified that reports have not been received. The Act gives the Commission broad authority to initiate enforcement actions against such candidates including civil enforcement and imposition of monetary penalties.

Factors considered by the Commission in levying fines include the number of days the filing is late and any previous violations that are on record with the Commission. In some cases, the Commission has imposed fines with two figures, for example "\$50/\$25." This notation means that the Commission has imposed a fine of \$50, which fine will be reduced to \$25 if payment is received within 30 days after service of a Final Decision.
