Frederick M. Herrmann, Executive Director of the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission, said that as of the 11-day preelection filing of October 23, 1987, Senate and Assembly candidates reported raising \$11,164,973 and spending \$7,388,129.

The figures update those provided in an earlier release which were based on the 29-day preelection report.

Herrmann said that spending in this election has already exceeded that for the entire general election of 1983, the last time that both the State Senate and Assembly were up for election.

In the general election of 1983, spending by Senate and Assembly candidates amounted to \$5,515,056.

Herrmann said that 1987 11-day preelection figures show that Senate candidates have raised \$5,199,876 compared to \$4,243,703 raised by Assembly

candidates. He said that expenditures made by Senate candidates were \$3,980,314 and by Assembly candidates \$2,997,923.

These reports show that Assembly receipts have decreased by 13 percent from the same period in 1985 and that Assembly expenditures have decreased by 15 percent from 1985. In 1985, Assembly candidates had raised \$4,898,382 and spent \$3,526,748.

Comparisons to the 1985 general election cannot be made for State Senate candidates because there was no Senate contest that year.

"As of 11 days prior to the election," said Herrmann, "Democrats have continued to outraise and outspend Republicans. Democrats have raised \$6,302,371 compared to the Republicans \$4,844,743. They have reported spending \$4,154,537 as opposed to the Republicans \$3,222,108. Independents have raised \$17,859 and spent \$11,484.

According to Herrmann, Democratic Assembly candidates received \$2,229,762 and Republican Assembly candidates \$1,996,082. Moreover, Democratic Assembly candidates spent \$1,465,723 compared to the Republicans \$1,520,716.

On the Senate side, Democrats reported raising \$3,294,100 and Republicans \$1,905,775. Democrats reported expenditures of \$2,278,922 and Republicans \$1,701,393.

The 11-day preelection reports indicate that incumbents have raised and spent more than their challengers. Herrmann said that incumbent receipts have amounted to \$6,580,200 thus far compared to \$3,695,980 received by challengers. He said that incumbents have reported spending \$4,225,872 and challengers \$3,162,257.

In 1987, Senate incumbents have raised \$3,942,815 compared to challengers \$2,089,663. They have spent \$2,583,172 while challengers have spent \$1,807,034.

Assembly incumbents, on the other hand, have raised \$2,637,386 compared to their challengers \$1,606,318. Assembly incumbents have reported expenditures of \$1,642,700 while challengers have spent \$1,355,223.

The breakdown between Assembly and Senate candidates, between incumbent and challenger candidates and between Republican and Democratic candidates do not equal the figures for total contributions. Some committees supported both Assembly and Senate candidates and it is not possible to attribute the funds raised among the Assembly and Senate candidates they supported. Therefore, funds raised by such committees were not counted in the totals. Similarly, it is not possible to divide funds raised by a political committee supporting both challenger and incumbent candidates between those candidates, so such committees were not tabulated in the incumbent/challenger figures. Finally, funds raised by Independent candidates were not counted in the political party figures.
