PRESS RELEASE

The New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC) will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, September 16, 1992, at 10:00 a.m. concerning proposed amendments to regulations pertaining to pre-candidacy activity, independent expenditures, and public financing of primary election candidates for Governor. The public hearing will be held at the Commission's offices on the 12th floor of 28 West State Street in Trenton.

The proposed amendments establish record keeping requirements for "testing the waters" activity, impose uniform recordkeeping requirements for expenditures by publicly financed gubernatorial candidates, and make various other technical changes.
