PRESS ADVISORY

The New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission announced today that it has proposed the readoption with amendments of its regulations pursuant to Executive Order 66 (1978). This process of review of the regulations and readoption is required to be conducted every five years.

The Commission's regulations have undergone examination and comprehensive amendment within the past five years as a result of statutory changes since the readoption of the rules in 1990. Legislation enacted in 1991 to amend the Legislative Activities Disclosure Act (N.J.S.A. 52:13C-18, et seq.) and in 1993 to amend the New Jersey Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1, et seq.) necessitated extensive regulatory activity during the past five years to implement the statutory changes. The rules pertaining to publicly-financed gubernatorial campaigns were amended in 1993 prior to the 1993 gubernatorial election. The text of the Commission regulations is therefore current and requires only minor technical amendments.

The proposed readoption with amendments will be published in the <u>New Jersey Register</u> on July 3, 1995. Copies of the proposal may be obtained by calling the Commission at (609) 292-8700.
