PRESS ADVISORY

The New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission announced today that it has proposed regulations to implement portions of the "Uniform Recall Election Law" (P.L. 1995, c.105). Pursuant to provisions of the "Uniform Recall Election Law," approved by Governor Christine Todd Whitman in May, 1995, the Commission is responsible for administering campaign reporting, committee registration, contribution limits and other requirements for recall elections. The Commission is not responsible for administration of the process for circulating recall petitions or for holding recall elections, which responsibilities are assigned exclusively to the officials authorized by law to receive nominating petitions for New Jersey elective offices.

These proposed regulations will appear in the <u>New Jersey Register</u> on October 2, 1995. Copies of the proposal may also be obtained by calling the Commission at (609) 292-8700.

The Commission will conduct a hearing to elicit public comment concerning the proposed regulations. The hearing will be held on Friday, October 20, 1995, at 3:30 p.m. at:
