**ORDER**

AND NOW, this 19 day of February, 2015, upon the unopposed application of plaintiff the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission ("Plaintiff" or "ELEC"), for an Order designating the distribution of the settlement payment in this action consistent with the terms of the Settlement Agreement and Release executed by Plaintiff and defendants Joseph Coniglio ("Coniglio"), Louis Romano ("L. Romano") and Theresa Romano ("T. Romano") (collectively, "Defendants"), and for good cause shown, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that Plaintiff's proposed distribution of the \$100,000 settlement amount shall be as follows: (a) \$30,000 shall be paid to ELEC; (b) the amount of Plaintiffs' attorneys' fees shall be paid to the Division of Law; (c) half of the final mediation bill shall be paid to the Mediator, Hon.

Thomas P. Olivieri, P.J.Ch. (Ret.), pursuant to the Court's Mediation Order; and (d) the amount remaining shall be paid to United Way of Bergen County pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-11.2(a)(2) and the equitable powers of the Court.
