PRESS ADVISORY

Three municipal, one county freeholder, and one state assembly candidates must pay fines and fees totaling approximately **\$1,281.96** for violating the Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act, the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC) announced today.

These enforcement actions, known as final decisions, were approved by the Commission at its March 19, 2019 meeting. In addition, ELEC on March 27, 2019 issued one complaint against a mayor and two municipal candidates for failure to comply with the Campaign Act. They too, could face fines.
