One state Senate, one state Assembly, two county commissioner, and five municipal candidates, along with a county political party committee, must pay fines and fees totaling \$58,091 for violations of the Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act, the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission announced today. These enforcement actions, known as final decisions, were approved by the Commission at its March 18, 2025 meeting.
